Introduction:

- What subject/question does the chapter deal with?
- What connects the chapter to previous chapters?
- What position does it have in relation to your research question?
- What is the aim of this chapter?
- What are the initial questions?
- How is the chapter structured?

Paragraph

- One central idea per paragraph
- The first sentence presents the central idea
- The following sentences elaborate on the central idea.
- The last sentence closes this elaboration or prepares for the next paragraph.
